The Mechanics is a 200 year old organization with a library formed in 1820 and the proud owner of Mechanics Hall, built in 1859 by the members for the members. The Hall has provided memorable service to Portland and the State by serving as City Hall for 2 years in 1866 and 1867; and served thousands of meals to Union troops. The Library, Ballroom Boardroom and Classroom served as a social and educational center for the tradesmen, artist, artisan, merchants, professionals and manufacturer community in the 1800's and 1900's and continues today for the new mechanics the makers, and creators of intellectual and physical products and items.
