Mechanics' Hall is a vibrant cultural organization celebrated for its historic library and performance space. We offer diverse programs that support and educate our creative community, serving as a resource for arts and humanities. We house the 8th oldest member-supported library in the U.S. and are part of the Membership Libraries Group, alongside esteemed institutions like the Athenaeum of Philadelphia and the New York Society Library.

In recent years, Mechanics' Hall gained recognition from the National Parks Service as a Nationally Significant building, supported by federal funding. We're renewing our interior space with a concept design plan by Epstein-Joslin + Picardy to better serve our community.

Our mission emphasizes diversity, equity, and inclusion across all aspects of Mechanics' Hall, from leadership to programming.

Mechanics' Hall strives to make knowledge, ideas, and arts accessible to all. We engage the community through cultural events and educational programs, preserving our landmark building as a place to gather, celebrate, and learn.

RECENT ACCOMPLISHMENTS

In the last year, we've significantly expanded our role as an arts incubator by hosting music and dance residencies and finding new opportunities to offer our space to our creative community in ways that elevate discourse, experience wonder, and inspire discovery. **Some highlights include hosting 40+ book launches and literary events, collaborating with an artists' collavorative from Cape Elizabeth, hosting residencies for NOISEFLOOR, and monthly creatives gathering by Signature Soul.**

HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE

Founding (1815) Mechanics' Hall traces its roots back to the Maine Charitable Mechanic Association (MCMA), founded 209 years ago to support Maine's creative community, which at the time included blacksmiths, coopers, artists, innovators, and creators.

Building Construction (1857-1859)

Mechanics' Hall, constructed during this period, is a testament to Portland's architectural and cultural history. The building opened doors for individuals with limited access to creative professions, books, and craftsmanship. Our mission today still maintains that everyone should have equal access to the arts and humanities.
